**ORDER AUTHORIZING A THIRD DISTRIBUTION OF THE NET CASH
SETTLEMENT AMOUNT AND *CY PRES* DISTRIBUTIONS TO APPROVED
ENTITIES**

AND NOW, upon consideration of Class Counsel’s Motion and Memorandum of Law for an Order Allowing a Third Distribution of the Net Cash Settlement Amount from the Zurich Settlement and permitting a Cy Pres Distribution to certain Entities, AND all of the briefs and supporting materials thereto,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED

1. The Court approves *cy pres* distribution of the amount previously set aside for this purpose by prior Order of the Court to the following four entities: (1) Consumer Action; (2) Consumer Watchdog; (3) The American Antitrust Institute (AAI); and (4) Risklink.org. Rust shall equally divide the amount among the four entities;
2. Rust shall reserve from the Net Settlement Fund \$250,000 for expenses relating to the Third Distribution of the Net Settlement Fund;

3. The remaining amount in the Net Settlement Fund, including the amounts remaining from unclaimed payments to members from certain Insurance Purchasing groups, shall be distributed to members of the class in a Third Distribution, all as set forth in the Blake Declaration;

4. Any residual amount remaining in the Net Settlement Fund after the Third Distribution (after reserving the amounts due for taxes), shall be equally distributed by the Claims Administrator to the four *Cy Pres* entities identified above;

5. The Claims Administrator is hereby authorized to close all settlement fund accounts in connection with the Zurich Settlement, and to destroy all paper and electronic copies of documents and other information provided by any Defendant or Settlement Class Member in connection with that Settlement, no earlier than 180 days after the completion of the Third Distribution.

6. The Court retains jurisdiction over any further application or matter which may arise in connection with the Action.
